Lesson:

2. What are some things that keep you from praying?

4. In general, why do we ask for things?
5. Why is it so hard to ask sometimes?
6. Read Ephesians 6:18. What does Paul tell us to pray for and when?
7. Read James 1:5-8. How does this passage describe prayer and the answers we receive?
8. What does it mean to seek something?
9. Why is it important that we seek in our prayers? Is it easy to grow weary in seeking?
10. Why do you knock on someone's door?
11. What is the importance of Matthew 7:10-11 in prayer? What does this teach about prayer, and how God will answer it?
