 - a. These are verses often used to demonstrate that that we are to sing only with our voices. But what else do these verses instruct us to do?
 - b. How do you sing and make music in your heart?
7. Are there any songs we sing that you might consider unscriptural? Any songs you ever saw a church place a stamp over and ask not to be sung?
