4. What are some things we can do to make sure we build our lives on a solid, Christ-based foundation?
5. Jesus ends his sermon on the mount looking at choices. Talk about these choices and which one(s) you struggle with the most:
 - a. Narrow road or Wide road
 - b. Good tree with good fruit or bad tree with bad fruit
 - c. Solid foundation or weak foundation
6. To close - talk about which portion of the sermon on the mount you find yourself most often drawn toward.
