### **QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION:**

1. Jesus said loving others/your neighbor is the second most important command.
  - a. How do you love others?
  - b. How do you love your enemies?
  - c. Is there anyone you should not love?
2. Can you think about a situation where someone returned love when the world would call for anger or hatred instead?
3. Why do you think Jesus said that the greatest command of all is to love God, and then to love others.
4. Like it was stated in the sermon - we are to love God with our everything. Look at the list below and talk about how you can love God with:
  - a. your desires
  - b. your thoughts
  - c. your words
  - d. your wardrobe
  - e. your possessions
5. Read over Luke 19:41-44. How does this demonstrate Jesus' love for his own enemies.
6. Read over 1 Corinthians 13.
  - a. Why is love such a key part to making us whole in Christ?
  - b. Why - if you speak with eloquence and have lots of faith, and if you give your possessions to the poor - does it mean nothing without love
