  - b. Put yourself in Abraham's shoes. What would be the most difficult part about God's command here?
  - c. God promises a few things in verses 2 and 3. Which one would be the biggest blessing to you? Why?
  - d. In what ways would God's call have been difficult for

Abraham?

2. What do the promises God makes to Abraham say about God's heart for mankind?
3. What did Abraham have to leave behind to answer God's call? What do you have to leave behind to answer God's call?
4. In the Bible, God routinely blesses people so they would in turn use those blessings to bless others.
  - a. Name people in the bible that this happened to
  - b. How can you use blessings of yours to bless others?
