### **Lesson:**

### **ICEBREAKER:**

Let's say you could turn back time to when you were 16 years old, and you were given the ability to choose any career/life path you want, regardless of talent, skill, education, etc. What would you choose?

### **QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION:**

1. Why do you think people have been asking for generations the question of "Why am I here?" or "What is the meaning of life?"
2. When you look at the story of creation in Genesis, what are

some of your favorite parts of it?

3. In Genesis 1:26, God says "Let us make man in our image." Who is God talking to? Who is us?
4. What sets apart the creation of man from the rest of creation?
5. God said "Let us make man in our image, in our likeness." What does this mean?
6. We pointed out a few things this morning that showed how the answer to this question (#5) solves our function in life.
  - a. God is perfect - does that mean we are perfect? (Matthew 5:48, 2 Peter 2:14)
  - b. God is light - were we created to be light? (I John 1:5; Psalm 104:2)
  - c. God is holy - are we holy? (I Peter 1:16; Leviticus 11:45; Hebrews 12:14)
  - d. God is love - are we to be love? (I John 4:7-8; I John 4:16)
