3. What did Mary use to anoint Jesus with?
4. Why was this significant?
5. What did the others in the room think about her sacrifice and anointment?

6. How would you have felt in that situation watching someone do that?
7. What sorts of sacrifices do Christians make today that others may not understand?
8. Why do you think Judas decided to betray Jesus?
9. What is greed? How much control can greed have over a person?
10. Read I Timothy 6:10 - what does this passage say about greed?
11. What does Judas do after he agrees to betray Jesus? Talk about how cold hearted that really is to do.
