Lesson:

QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION:

1. What do you do during Communion? What do you think about? How do you stay focused? Do you have a hard time staying focused?
2. Read Mark 14:27-31.
 - a. Which disciple said they'd never leave Jesus? (vs 29, 31)
 - b. Do you think Peter was trying to throw the others under the bus in his statement in vs 29?

- c. How do you think the disciples felt when Jesus told them they would scatter?
3. Gethsemane:
 - a. What does the word mean?
 - b. Who does he pull aside?
 - c. Read Mark 10:39 and Mark 14:29-31. Does this add any significance in why Jesus chose these 3?
 - d. Why else would he choose them?
 - e. Mark's account of Gethsemane feature some really dark and troubling words in vs 33. Why was Jesus deeply distressed and troubled?
 - f. Aside from what is written, what do you think Jesus did and said while praying to God?
 - g. Why is Jesus' phrase to the disciples "Watch out" a spiritual warning?
 - h. How is that relevant to us?
