Lesson:

Today is the sixth sermon in a series of lessons entitled "Resurrection Way." We will walk through time as we talk about the events leading up to the Resurrection. Today we look at the trial and death of Jesus at the crucifixion.

ICEBREAKER:

You've been put on trial for something you didn't do. What famous lawyer - fiction or real life - do you want to represent you?

QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION:

1. Skim over Mark 14:66-72
 - a. How many times did Peter end up denying he knew Jesus?
 - b. How did Peter deny him?
 - c. Do you think Peter even thought about what he was doing as he denied Jesus, or was he "self defense" mode?
2. Look at Numbers 35:30; Deuteronomy 17:6; 19:15-21. How does this tie to Jesus and

his time before the Sanhedrin in Mark 14:53-65?

3. What is blasphemy? Why did the high priest call Jesus blasphemous?
4. Why did the Sanhedrin have to take Jesus to the Roman Governor instead of just killing him themselves?
5. Who was Barabbas?
6. Many things happened to Jesus - false trials, beatings, being spit on, being mocked, crown of thorns, etc. Aside from the actual crucifixion - which of these things hurts you the most (either physically or mentally) to think about Jesus going through?
7. Why do you think the Centurion said "Surely this was the Son of God."
