3. Read Matthew 10:5-8. How do these verses affect your understanding of our mission here on earth?
4. How can we be effective if we don't have the powers to heal the sick and raise the dead like the disciples did?
5. Read Matthew 10:12-15. These verses give some very practical suggestions for dealing with people.
 - a. What do these verses teach us?
 - b. How does Jesus' suggestion for dealing with people who won't accept the message make you feel? Is that easy to do?
6. Verse 15 is a sad commentary on people who do not accept God's message. Do you know people you need to reach? How do you get them to listen to God's message?
